

## Master's Certificate in Public Sector Management

The Master's Certificate in Public Sector Management (MCPSM) is an executive education program designed to expand and equip the competencies of professionals who are employed within the public sector. All courses are designed and taught by subject experts who provide thought provoking and innovative perspectives and will encourage best-practices in communication, leadership and management strategies that are relevant to government or public organizations.

Participants will explore strategic topics during 15 days (September to April) with other public sector leaders who share similar challenges within a safe environment.
