

Master's Project or Major Paper *Example* Timeline Students and Supervisors

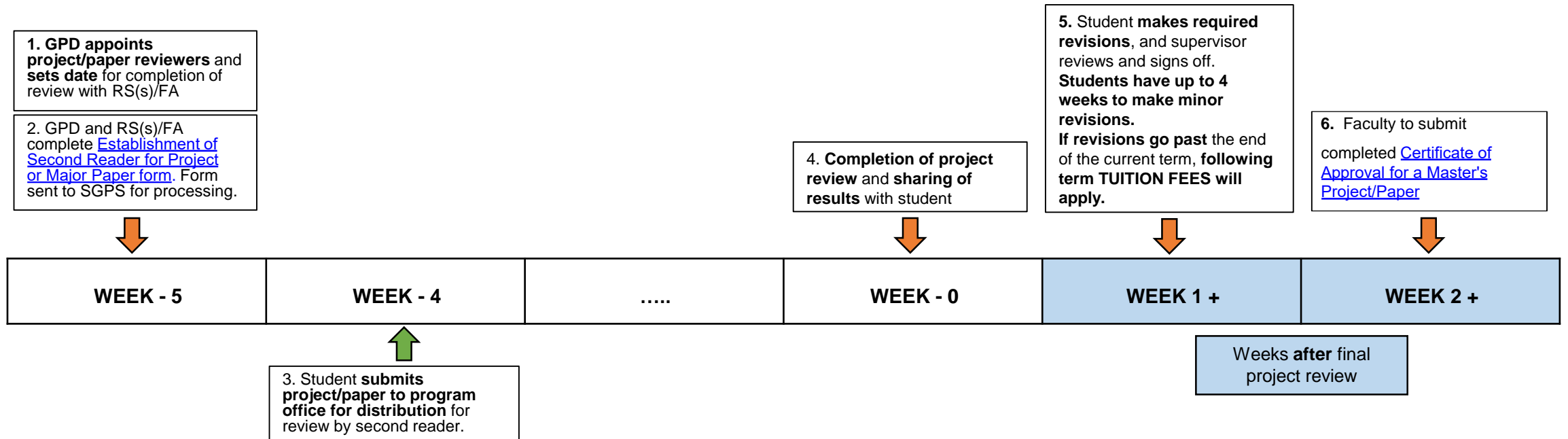
The best way to prepare for the final submission of your Master's Project/Major Paper is to plan ahead and communicate with your Research Supervisor(s)/Faculty advisory, your program office, and the School of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies (SGPS).

Under normal circumstances the Master's Project/Major Paper review process should begin 5 week prior to the desired completion date.

It is essential this information is used in combination with the [Master's Project/Major Paper Handbook](#) and the [Graduate Academic Calendar](#) available on the Graduate Studies website.
